TONIGHT WE WELCOME SHEFFORD TOWN AND CAMPTON TO THE JSJ IN A MIDWEEK LOCAL DERBY UNDER THE LIGHTS.

AFTER AN OPENING DAY WIN OVER WHITWORTHS WE'VE SUFFERED TWO DEFEATS AT IRCHESTER AND BUCKINGHAM. AT IRCHESTER WE WERE NOT GOOD FROM WORD GO BUT STAYED IN THE GAME UNTIL THEY GOT TWO GOALS IN THE LAST TEN MINUTES. THE BOYS SEEMED TO REACT TO A HALF TIME ROLLICKING AND WITH THE INTRODUCTION OF THE ENERGETIC MULLINS WE PROPER WENT AT THEM. HOW WE NEVER SCORED IS BEYOND ME BUT CREDIT TO THE BUCKINGHAM GK WHO HAD AN UNBELIEVABLE 25 MINUTES. # **A VIEW FROM THE CHAIR**

## **ROB PARKIN**

**GOOD EVENING EVERYONE AND A VERY WARM WELCOME TO THE JSJ STADIUM TO YOU ALL. I WOULD ALSO LIKE TO EXTEND A VERY WARM WELCOME TO SHEFFORD TOWN AND CAMPTON FC, ALL THEIR PLAYERS, MANAGEMENT, SUPPORTERS, COMMITTEE & EVERYONE WHO HAS COME ALONG THIS EVENING. ALL AT SFC HOPE YOU ENJOY YOUR TIME WITH US.**

**OUR RESERVES OPENED THEIR 2025/26 SEASON WITH A HOME 2-1 WIN AGAINST A STRONG WELLINGBOROUGH WHITWORTHS TEAM. UNFORTUNATELY THEY DID NOT FAIR SO WELL ON THEIR TRAVELS TO IRCHESTER. IT WAS A GAME WHERE WE DID NOT REALLY GET GOING AND IRCHESTER TAKING THEIR OPPORTUNITIES RUNNING OUT 3-1 WINNERS. WE KNEW IRCHESTER WOULD BE STRONG, MAKING THE PLAY OFF'S LAST SEASON AND THEY LOOK STRONG CANDIDATES TO ACHIEVE THIS AGAIN THIS SEASON OR BETTER.**

**LAST SATURDAY WE TRAVELLED TO BUCKINGHAM ANOTHER GROUND THAT HAS NOT BEEN KIND TO US IN THE PAST, AND IT WAS NOT AGAIN WITH BUCKINGHAM WINNING 1-0. IT WAS A GAME WHERE WE CREATED A LOT OF CHANCES BUT FAILED TO FINISH THEM OFF. A COMBINATION OF MISSED OPPORTUNITIES AND THE OPPOSITION'S KEEPER MAKING SOME EXCELLENT SAVES WERE OUR UNDOING. JON AND HIS TEAM WILL BE LOOKING TO MAKE AMENDS THIS EVENING AGAINST SHEFFORD WHO HAVE ALSO HAD A SLOW START TO THEIR SEASON.**

**OUR 1ST TEAM HAVE ALSO HAD A DIFFICULT START WITH AN EARLY EXIT FROM THE FA CUP AT THE HANDS OF REDBRIDGE. REDBRIDGE WERE MUCH THE STRONGER TEAM, WELL ORGANISED AND FULLY DESERVED THEIR 4-0 WIN. NO EXCUSES, BUT OUR PRE-SEASON SCHEDULE WAS DISRUPTED WITH TEAMS PULLING OUT AT THE LAST MINUTE, NOT THE BEST PREPARATION ESPECIALLY A FEW DAYS BEFORE OUR FIRST COMPETITIVE GAME. LAST SATURDAY WE HOSTED BEACONSFIELD WHOM WE HAD TWO TOUGH GAMES LAST SEASON A 2-2 AT HOME AND LOSING OUT BY THE ODD GOAL 2-3 AWAY. BEACONSFIELD ARE A TALL AND ORGANISED TEAM WHERE IN THE FIRST HALF WE STRUGGLED TO COPE WITH THEIR AERIAL DOMINANCE, GOING 2-0 BEHIND WITHIN THE FIRST 20 MINUTES. EDDIE MADE CHANGE TO OUR FORMATION AND WE SLOWLY CAME BACK INTO THE GAME, CERTAINLY HAVING A MUCH BETTER SECOND HALF. BEACONSFIELD ROUNDED THE GAME OFF WINNING 3-0 SCORING IN THE 91ST MINUTE. TAKING ALL ONBOARD I THINK WE WILL SEE A DIFFERENT FORMATION AS THE 1ST TEAM TRAVEL TO WARE THIS EVENING.**

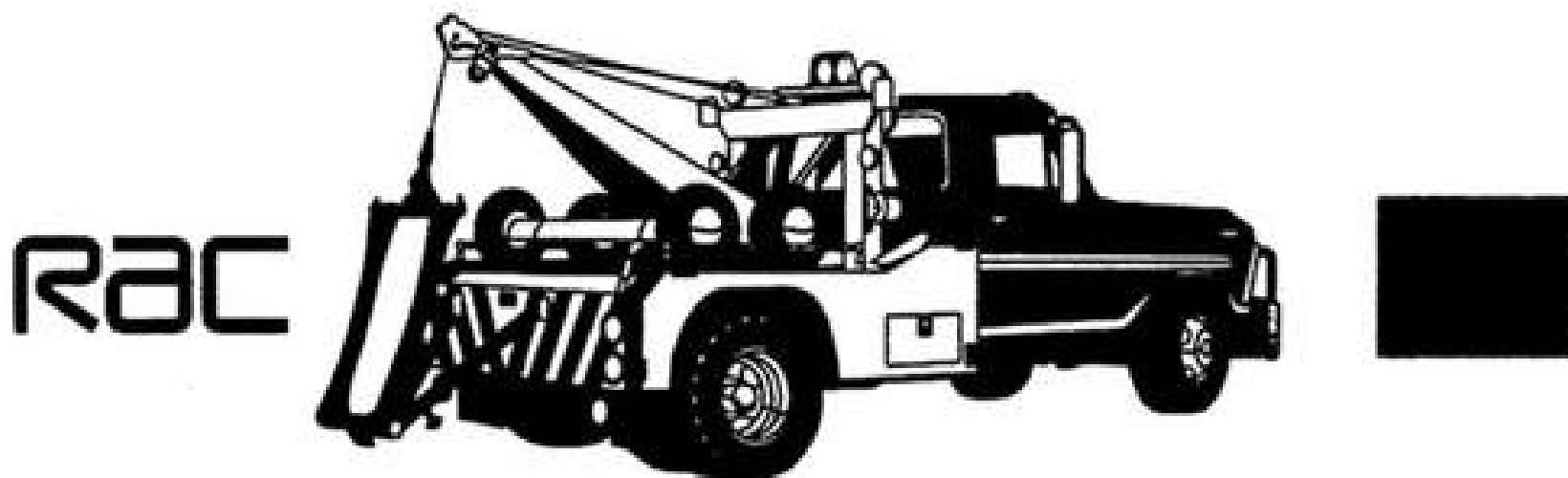

# THE HOME TEAM

**STOTFOLD**

STOTFOLD IS A SMALL COUNTRY TOWN WITH A POPULATION IN THE REGION OF 9,000. IT IS SITUATED IN THE COUNTY OF BEDFORDSHIRE BUT BEING NEAR THE NORTH HERTS BORDER. THE FIRST RECORDED FOOTBALL IN THE TOWN WAS 1904, HOWEVER IT IS CERTAIN THAT THE GAME WAS PLAYED FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS BEFORE THAT. IN THOSE EARLY 1900S, STOTFOLD SIDES PLAYED IN THE BIGGLESWADE AND DISTRICT LEAGUE. THIS WAS FOLLOWED BY A SPELL OF NEARLY 30 YEARS IN NORTH HERTS FOOTBALL. THE FIRST RECORD OF A TROPHY BEING WON WAS 1911 WHEN POTTON WERE BEATEN 1-0 IN THE BIGGLESWADE AND DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIP. STOTFOLD FC WAS OFFICIALLY FOUNDED AFTER WW2 IN 1946. IN 1951 WE JOINED THE SOUTH MIDLANDS LEAGUE DIVISION 2 AND IN 1953 WERE PROMOTED TO DIVISION 1. UP UNTIL 1965 OUR HOME GROUND WAS LOCATED AT HITCHIN ROAD RECREATION GROUND AND THE CLUB THEN PURCHASED AND DEVELOPED A MEADOW NAMED ROKER AND THE GROUND WAS APTLY NAMED ROKER PARK WHICH WE OCCUPIED FOR 54 YEARS. THE CLUB REMAINED IN THE SOUTH MIDLANDS LEAGUE FOR OVER 30 YEARS WINNING PROMOTION TO THE PREMIER LEAGUE IN 1955 AND WINNING THE CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1980. PHIL PATEMAN TOOK OVER FROM IAN ALLINSON STEPPING UP AFTER MANAGING THE RESERVES TO LEAGUE CHAMPIONS AND BEDS INTERMEDIATE SUCCESS. DURING 1998-2001 UNDER HIS CHARGE THE CLUB WON THE BEDS SENIOR AND PREMIER CUPS, UCL LEAGUE CUP, AND THE HINCHINGBROOKE CUP. THE CLUB ALSO REACHED THE LAST 32 OF THE FA VASE AND THE 3RD QUALIFYING RD OF THE FA CUP. PHIL STEPPED DOWN TO BECOME CHAIRMAN IN 2001.



**THE EARLY 2000S SAW CHALLENGING TIMES FOR STOTFOLD CLUB AFTER GAINING JUST 11 POINTS FROM 17 LEAGUE GAMES AND SOME HEAVY DEFEATS IN SEASON 2006/7. A PARTNERSHIP OF IAN ALLISON AND IAN DONNELLY TOOK OVER AND WITH THE CLUB STARING RELEGATION IN THE FACE, IAN RECRUITED SEVERAL SENIOR PLAYERS, AND THE CLUB HAULED THEMSELVES OUT OF THE BOTTOM TWO, WINNING 8 OF THE LAST 10 GAMES. DURING THE SUMMER OF 2007, THE SQUAD STRENGTHENED FURTHER, CULMINATING IN THE MOST SUCCESSFUL SEASON IN THE CLUB'S HISTORY. BOTH FIRST AND SECOND TEAM SQUADS WON THEIR RESPECTIVE LEAGUE AND COUNTY CUP COMPETITIONS, (THE FIRST CLUB AND TO DATE ONLY ONE TO DO SO), WITH THE SECOND TEAM UNDER JOHN PHILBIN REMAINING UNBEATEN IN THE LEAGUE.**

**THE 2010S SAW THE CLUB MOVE BACK FROM THE UNITED COUNTIES LEAGUE TO THE SPARTAN SOUTH MIDLANDS LEAGUE IN 2010/11. IN SEASON 2012/13 GORDON BICKERSTAFF STOOD DOWN AND STEVE YOUNG WAS APPOINTED AS MANAGER SUPPORTED BY ROY RYALL. AFTER ANOTHER POOR START THE FIRST TEAM SECURED A RESPECTABLE MID-TABLE POSITION. STEVE PROMOTED FROM WITHIN THE CLUB, MICHAEL PARKIN AND MATT ENDERSBY STEPPING UP. THE FIRST TEAM TURNED THEIR SEASON AROUND FROM BEING 3RD FROM BOTTOM OF THE SSML PREMIER DIVISION WITH JUST 18 POINTS AT XMAS, TO THREE CUP FINALS AND A SEMI-FINAL PLACE IN ANOTHER. THEY ALSO MOVED AWAY FROM THE FOOT OF THE TABLE WITH A FURTHER 29 POINTS IN THE SECOND HALF OF THE SEASON. THE MID-2010S PRESENTED A CHALLENGE AND FOLLOWING STEVE'S RESIGNATION IN JANUARY 2015, ROB BATES STEPPED UP AND HE MANAGED TO MOULD A TEAM TO STAVE OFF RELEGATION FROM THE PREMIER LEAGUE AND FINISH A CREDITABLE 16TH. REVISED PLANS WERE DRAWN UP WHEN AN OFFER TO BUILD 60 PROPERTIES ON ROKER PARK WAS ACCEPTED IN RETURN FOR A STADIUM BEING BUILT FOR US.**

**THE CLUB COMPLETELY RESTRUCTURED WITH A MERGER OF SENIOR & JUNIOR CLUBS WITH AN ONGOING PROGRAM OF INCLUSIVE FOOTBALL FOR A CHARTER STANDARD CLUB COMPRISING OF MORE THAN 60 TEAMS AND 700 PARTICIPANTS. SO, TO THE 2020S SUCCESS OFF THE FIELD BEING AS IMPORTANT AS ON IT. IN THIS REGARD WE WERE DELIGHTED THAT OUR FORMER PLAYER LUKE GREGSON AGREED TO BE OUR MANAGER AFTER A WONDERFUL SPELL AT BALDOCK. HE BOUGHT WITH HIM JIM STERLING AND REBUILT THE SIDE. AFTER A SLOW START THE EAGLES WENT ON A FANTASTIC RUN OF FORM WINNING 14 CONSECUTIVE LEAGUE GAMES AND SEEMINGLY NAILED ON FOR PROMOTION BEFORE COVID-19 NULL AND VOIDED THE SEASON. HOWEVER NOT BEFORE WE WON THE BEDS SENIOR TROPHY BEATING STEVINGTON 2-0 IN THE FINAL. DESPITE, THE DISAPPOINTMENT 2020 MARKED A LANDMARK FOR THE CLUB WHEN WE MOVED TO OUR NEW ROKER PARK JSJ STADIUM. THE £2M STEP 4 FACILITY OPENED ITS DOORS ON FEB 8TH WITH A HOME GAME AGAINST SHEFFORD & CAMPTON, AND A CROWD OF 644 WITNESSED A SUPER GAME WITH THE EAGLES WINNING 5-3.**



**AFTER 20 YEARS AS CLUB CHAIRMAN PHIL PATEMAN STEPPED DOWN AT THE END OF SEASON 2020/21 WITH HIS VICE-CHAIRMAN OF SOME 4 YEARS ROB PARKIN AGREEING TO TAKE ON THE ROLE OF CHAIRMAN. WE STARTED THE NEW 2021/22 SEASON FULL OF OPTIMISM HAVING BEEN RE-STRUCTURED OFF THE FIELD AND IN THE RE-STRUCTURED DIVISION 1 UNDER FORMER PLAYERS BRETT AND PAUL DONNELLY. JOINING BRETT'S MANAGEMENT TEAM IS UEFA B LICENCE AND FA COACH MENTOR EDDIE MCLOUGHLIN. THE MANAGEMENT TEAM ARE COMPLETED BY MICHAEL PARKIN (GOALKEEPING COACH), RYAN JEFFERIES (PHYSIO) AND ROY RYALL WITH JON LITTLE, SEAN LYNESS AND DARREN CLARKE LOOKING AFTER THE DEVELOPMENT/U18 SIDES. THE SEASON SAW UNPRECEDENTED SUCCESS WITH THE FIRST TEAM WINNING DIVISION 1 AND PROMOTION BACK TO THE SOUTH MIDLANDS PREMIER DIVISION, THE DEVELOPMENT TEAM WINNING DIVISION 1 OF THE BEDS COUNTY FOOTBALL LEAGUE AND PROMOTION TO PREMIER DIVISION AND THE U18S WINNING THE NEMEAN DIVISION OF THE SOUTHERN COUNTIES SOUTHERN FLOODLIT LEAGUE.**



**WE STARTED SEASON 2022/23 WITH THE SAME MANAGEMENT TEAMS FOR THE FIRST AND DEVELOPMENT TEAMS AND THE CLUB HAD THEIR FIRST EVER WOMEN'S TEAM UNDER THE MANAGEMENT OF TOM OLNEY AND BECCA LIGHTFOOT PLAYING IN THE BEDS AND HERTS WOMAN'S FOOTBALL LEAGUE. A NEW MANAGEMENT TEAM OF STUART LOPEZ AND SCOTT CRETTON TOOK OVER THE U18 TEAM. UNBELIEVABLY THE FIRST TEAM SECURED BACK-TO-BACK PROMOTIONS FINISHING RUNNERS UP IN THE SSMFL PREMIER DIVISION AND WINNING THE PLAY OFF AT DEREHAM TOWN 2-0. THE WOMEN'S TEAM SECURED PROMOTION TO THE PREMIER DIVISION OF THEIR LEAGUE IN THEIR FIRST SEASON.**

**SEASON 2023/24 SAW THE 1ST TEAM PLAY AT STEP 4 IN THE SOUTHERN LEAGUE CENTRAL DIVISION 1 FOR THE FIRST TIME IN THE CLUB'S HISTORY. IN A TOUGH LEAGUE WE WERE DELIGHTED TO FINISH A VERY CREDITABLE 7TH. THE DEVELOPMENT TEAM FINISHED RUNNERS-UP IN THE BEDS COUNTY FOOTBALL LEAGUE, GAINING PROMOTION TO SPARTAN SOUTH MIDLANDS DIVISION 1 A GREAT ACHIEVEMENT FOR A CLUB TO HAVE TEAMS AT STEP 4 AND STEP 6. THE WOMEN'S TEAM FINISHED THIRD IN THEIR FIRST SEASON IN THE PREMIER DIVISION AND THE U18S FINISHED THIRD IN THE DELPHIAN DIVISION. SADLY, WE SAW BRETT AND EDDIE MOVE ON TO TAKE OVER MANAGEMENT ROLES AT HITCHIN TOWN TOWARDS THE END OF THE SEASON. WE THANK THEM FOR ALL THE SUCCESS THEY BROUGHT TO THE CLUB.**

# THE VISITORS



## SHEFFORD TOWN AND CAMPTON

**SHEFFORD TOWN FOOTBALL CLUB WAS FOUNDED IN 1910, AND PLAYED ITS FIRST MATCHES THAT SEPTEMBER IN THE BIGGLESWADE AND DISTRICT JUNIOR LEAGUE. HOME GAMES WERE HELD AT IVEL ROAD, AND THE CLUB REMAINED IN THAT COMPETITION UNTIL THE 1949–50 SEASON, WHEN THEY STEPPED UP TO THE SOUTH MIDLANDS LEAGUE. IT WAS AN IMMEDIATE SUCCESS — THEY LIFTED THE BEDS SENIOR CUP IN THEIR DEBUT SEASON, REPEATED THE FEAT IN 1953, AND ADDED FURTHER WINS IN 1955 ALONGSIDE BACK-TO-BACK LEAGUE TITLES. THESE ACHIEVEMENTS EARNED THEM A PLACE IN THE PARTHENON LEAGUE, WHERE THEY FACED TEAMS FROM MUCH FURTHER AFIELD, WITH SOME AWAY TRIPS REACHING AS FAR AS LONDON.**

**SHEFFORD QUICKLY ADAPTED, FINISHING AS RUNNERS-UP IN THEIR FIRST PARTHENON LEAGUE CAMPAIGN. BUT AFTER THREE SEASONS OF LONG TRAVEL AND A SPARSE FIXTURE LIST, THE CLUB DECIDED TO JOIN THE MORE LOCAL UNITED COUNTIES LEAGUE. THAT PROVED A WISE MOVE — IN 1960–61 THEY WON THE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP AND, IN THE VERY SAME WEEK, CLAIMED THE NORTH BEDS CHARITY CUP.**

**THE FOLLOWING YEAR BROUGHT A DRAMATIC CHANGE IN FORTUNES AS THEY FINISHED SECOND FROM BOTTOM, PROMPTING A RETURN TO THE SOUTH MIDLANDS LEAGUE. THEY CAME THIRD IN THEIR FIRST SEASON BACK, AND IN 1973–74 FINISHED RUNNERS-UP AGAIN. HOWEVER, 1975–76 ENDED IN RELEGATION, AND IT WASN'T UNTIL THE EARLY 1980S THAT SHEFFORD RETURNED TO FORM. THE 1982–83 SEASON SAW THEM LIFT THE DIVISION ONE TITLE, AND THEY FOLLOWED IT WITH THE OVERALL LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1983–84, ALSO WINNING THE NORTH BEDS CHARITY CUP, THE BIGGLESWADE KNOCKOUT CONTEST, AND THE BEDFORDSHIRE INTERMEDIATE CUP. THE NORTH BEDS CHARITY AND BIGGLESWADE KNOCKOUT DOUBLE WAS REPEATED THE NEXT YEAR.**

# THE VISITORS

## SHEFFORD TOWN AND CAMPTON

THE LATE 1980S WERE MORE DIFFICULT. SHEFFORD SLIPPED TO THE BOTTOM OF THE TABLE IN 1989—90 AND DROPPED BACK INTO DIVISION ONE. THREE YEARS LATER, LEAGUE REORGANISATION PLACED THEM IN THE SENIOR DIVISION, WHERE PERFORMANCES IMPROVED, INCLUDING A FIFTH-PLACE FINISH IN 1993—94. BUT BY THE END OF THAT SEASON, THE CLUB HAD BEEN WOUND UP, PLAYING ITS FINAL MATCH ON 18 MAY 1994.

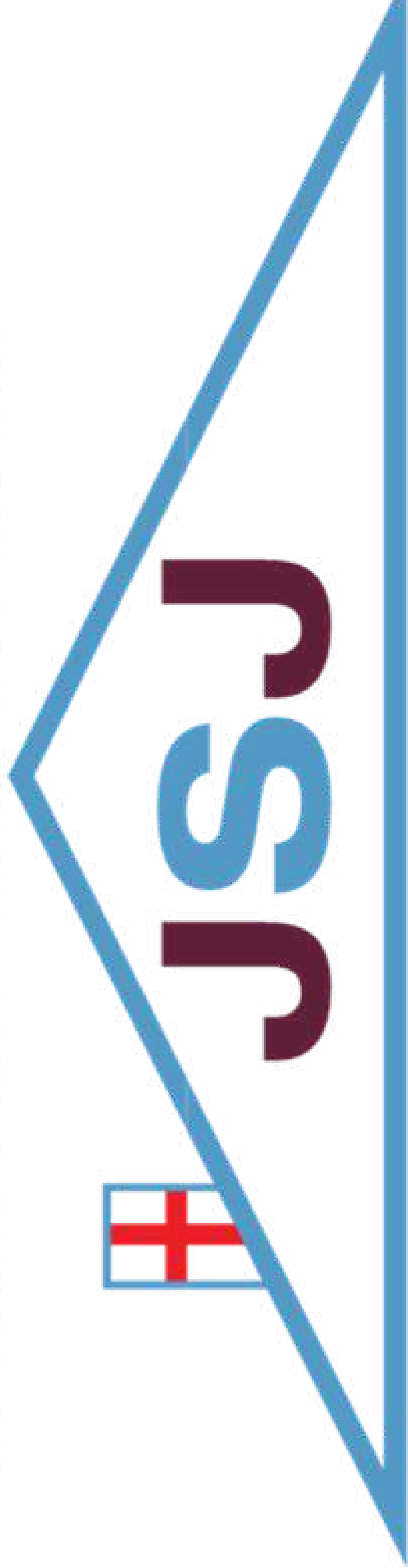
FIFTEEN YEARS LATER, IN 2009, SHEFFORD TOWN WAS REBORN THANKS TO DAN PINKERTON AND GRAHAM EARL, BOTH ACTIVE IN LOCAL YOUTH FOOTBALL. THE REFORMED CLUB ENTERED THE BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY FOOTBALL LEAGUE'S DIVISION TWO FOR THE 2009—10 SEASON.

SINCE THEN, SHEFFORD HAVE ENJOYED SUCCESS BOTH ON AND OFF THE PITCH. THEY WERE CROWNED BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY PREMIER DIVISION CHAMPIONS IN 2011—12, 2017—18, AND 2018—19, AND COLLECTED THE BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY LEAGUE BRITANNIA CUP IN 2011 AND 2014. THE RESERVE SIDE ADDED THE EAST BEDS CHARITY CUP IN 2015, WHILE THE FIRST TEAM REACHED THE BIGGLESWADE KNOCKOUT CUP FINAL THREE YEARS IN A ROW FROM 2015 TO 2017.

AT THE END OF THE 2018—19 SEASON, THE CLUB EARNED PROMOTION TO THE SPARTAN SOUTH MIDLANDS FOOTBALL LEAGUE AFTER WINNING THE COUNTY LEAGUE TITLE AND MEETING THE NECESSARY GROUND STANDARDS. IN 2021—22, SHEFFORD TOWN & CAMPTON ENTERED THE FA VASE FOR THE FIRST TIME, REACHING THE THIRD ROUND.

THEN CAME ANOTHER MILESTONE — THE 2022—23 SEASON SAW THE CLUB MAKE ITS FA CUP DEBUT, GOING ALL THE WAY TO THE THIRD QUALIFYING ROUND, MARKING ANOTHER PROUD CHAPTER IN SHEFFORD TOWN'S STORY.

BIGGLESWADE 1 (FRIENDLY MATCH) ATT 80 APPROX

THIS WAS A GLORIOUS NIGHT FOR FOOTBALL

AND THE GAME STARTED BY THE TIME THE HEAT OF THE DAY HAD DEPARTED, EVENTUALLY BECOMING PLEASANTLY COLD ENOUGH TO PUT ON THE JUMPER I'D BROUGHT WITH ME. FOR ME THIS IS THE TIME OF THE YEAR ALL 'HIGH' LEVEL FOOTBALL SHOULD BE PLAYED. IN MY OPINION THE SEASON SHOULD RUN FROM MARCH TO DECEMBER, WITH ALL GAMES BEING PLAYED IN THE EVENINGS, WHEN THE WEATHER IS MORE LIKE IT WAS TONIGHT. AS ALWAYS, THE FACILITIES LOOKED GOOD HERE TONIGHT. THIS INCLUDES THE PITCH WHICH ALTHOUGH IT WAS WELL PREPARED, SUFFERED FROM THE LACK OF RECENT RAIN, IT WAS A MIXTURE AND BROWN GREEN IN COLOUR. PERHAPS THE CLUB COULD RUN A SECRET HOSE PIPE FROM THE SCENIC ADJACENT SEWAGE FARM? AS FOR THE GAME, THIS WAS A STEP 5 VERSUS STEP 4 GAME AND SO AN AWAY WIN WAS KIND OF EXPECTED, NOT THAT RESULTS MEAN MUCH AT THIS TIME OF THE YEAR, EXCEPT TO SAY THAT GETTING PLAYERS FIT AT THE START OF THE SEASON ISN'T QUITE SUCH AN ISSUE AS IT USED TO BE, AS PLAYERS AT THIS LEVEL TEND TO KEEP THEMSELVES PRETTY FIT THROUGHOUT THE YEAR ANYWAY. I'D ALREADY SEEN POTTON PLAY ON THE PREVIOUS TUESDAY, WHERE THEY DREW NIL-NIL AT LETCHWORTH GARDEN CITY EAGLES, WHICH WAS NOT A GREAT SPECTACLE FOR THE NEUTRALS, BUT BOTH SIDES GAVE IT A GO. TONIGHT WAS MUCH THE SAME EXCEPT THAT OVERALL POTTON PLAYED MUCH BETTER THIS EVENING WITH THEIR ENERGY LEVELS BEING HIGHER. BUT THEIR VISITORS STILL LOOKED BETTER THIS EVENING AND THEY HAD THE BETTER OF THE FIRST 20 MINUTES BEFORE POTTON GOT INTO IT, HITTING THE CROSSBAR TWICE IN ONE MOVEMENT ON THE HALF HOUR POINT AND BY HALF TIME POSSESSION WAS ROUGHLY EVEN. BOTH SIDES MADE CHANGES AT THE BREAK AND FOR A WHILE BIGGLESWADE'S SUBS LOOKED A LOT BETTER THAN THEIR HOSTS, BUT BY THE END OF THE GAME GENERAL TIREDNESS HAD AFFECTED BOTH SIDES. BIGGLESWADE DID SCORE THOUGH, ON 56 MINUTES WHEN FROM A CORNER THE BALL WAS TURNED IN AT THE NEAR POST, ALMOST ON THE LINE. AT THIS STAGE OF THE SEASON THE ONLY THING WORTH NOTING WAS THAT AFTER TWO MATCHES POTTON HAD YET TO SCORE!

THIS WAS ONE OF THE MORE UNUSUAL

FRIENDLIES IN THAT IT WAS PLAYED AT A VENUE ROUGHLY HALF WAY BETWEEN THE COMPETING SIDES. ALSO IT WAS PLAYED OUT ON A WELCOME COOLER DAY OF LATE, WITH THE SUN FINALLY APPEARING AS THE GAME DREW TO A CLOSE. STEP 4 CORBY WERE THE 'SENIOR' SIDE TODAY HAVING FINISHED 2 ND IN THE NORTHERN PREMIER LEAGUE DIVISION 1 MIDLANDS LEAGUE LAST SEASON. I'D SEEN AFC WELWYN IMPRESSIVELY BEAT A BUNCH OF POTTERS BAR TOWN TRIALLISTS ON THE PREVIOUS SATURDAY, BUT COULD THEY HANDLE TODAY'S OPPONENTS WITHOUT GETTING OUT OF THEIR DEPTH? BY THE END WE FOUND OUT THAT THEY COULD AND ALSO, ON THESE SHOWINGS, THEY COULD BECOME ONE OF THE FAVOURITES TO WIN THE SSML PREMIER DIVISION THIS SEASON. THE BEST PART OF THIS MATCH WAS IN THE FIRST HALF, ESPECIALLY IN THE MIDDLE OF THE PERIOD, WHEN ALL FOUR OF THE GAME'S GOALS WERE SCORED.
