Balham FC was formed in 2011 in order to provide player progression into open age football for the hugely talented, high achieving age group teams of Balham Blazers FC, which was founded by Greg Cruttwell in 2001.

Having won back-to-back promotions in 2011/12 and 2012/13 Balham did the league and cup double in the Surrey South Eastern Combination in 2013/14.

In 2014/15 Balham finished in a promotion position again, in the Surrey Elite Intermediate Football League, however promotion was denied due to Combined Counties League facility requirements not being met.

Having moved to ground share with Cobham FC, in order to meet the facility requirements, Balham finished as runners up in the SEIFL in 2015/16 and as a result were promoted to Division One of the Combined Counties League for the 2016/17 season.

The club had an exceptional first league campaign at Step 6, finishing in a promotion position for the sixth consecutive season and winning the London Senior Trophy.

In 2017/18 the club had an equally exceptional season, finishing 5th at Step 5 in the Premier Division of the CCL and winning the London Senior Cup.

2021/22 will be the club's fifth season at this level after flirting with relegation in 2018/19 and then having a null and void seasons in 2019/20 and 2020/21 due to COVID-19.

Having begun on Wimbledon Extension, before moving to Cobham and then to the Wibbandune Stadium, where the club ground shared with Colliers Wood Utd, Balham were on the move again in 2020, this time to the Mayfield Stadium, where the club has embarked on a two year ground share agreement with AFC Croydon Athletic.

Moving location meant having to move sideways in the Football League Pyramid, from the Premier Division of the CCL into the Premier Division of the SCEFL (South East Counties Football League)

After one single season in the SCEFL however, which was curtailed due to COVID-19, the FA have brought Balham back to the Combined Counties League for the 2021/22 season, at the same level, in a newly formed Premier League South.

GUILDFORD CITY FC

1921 - 1974

The first club in the town were amateur and were formed in 1877 as Guildford FC., known as the "Pinks". By the end of 1920 a professional side was formed, and in May 1921 they were accepted into the Southern League, the equivalent of today's National League. 1927 saw Guildford become a Diocese and coupled with the planned cathedral, it was believed that Guildford would become a city so the club was renamed Guildford City. In 1928-29 City were drawn at home to Queen's Park Rangers in the FA Cup First Round proper and won 4-2 in front of almost 8,000 spectators. The immediate pre-war years saw another famous FA Cup victory, this time over Reading, whilst 1937/38 saw Guildford City lift the Southern League Championship for the first time. The following year a record crowd of 9,932 spectators crammed into Joseph's Road to watch an epic FA Cup First Round replay versus local rivals Aldershot. In 1951, City sold future England cap Jimmy Langley to Leeds. Another League Championship was achieved in 1955-56, and then in 1967-68 Guildford embarked upon a memorable FA Cup run. Leading 2-1 at Brentford in the First-Round proper, the match was abandoned due to snow. A 2-2 draw in the rearranged fixture saw 7,289 fans cram into Joseph's Road to roar City on to a famous 2-1 victory in the replay. A further 8,774 saw City fall narrowly to Newport County in the Second Round, and the heroes of that era, players like Tony Burge and long-serving Darby Watts, will be remembered for ever as legends. In 1974 on-going financial problems came to a head and, despite the best efforts of Bill Bellerby and John Daborn, it was announced that the Club was to merge with Dorking. The final game at Joseph's Road was played on 12 February 1974, when City beat Folkestone 2-0 in front of 625 fans. The club limped on for a further two seasons playing as Guildford & Dorking before finally succumbing on 9 December 1976.

1996 – Present

After years of discussions and false starts the club re-emerged as AFC Guildford in 1996 when the then Mayor of Guildford John Woodhatch persuaded Burpham FC to change its name and move to the Spectrum Leisure Centre. After a spell in the Surrey Premier League, Guildford joined the newly formed Combined Counties League (CCL), winning Division One in 2003-04. After a 12-month period as Guildford United, the club was re-named the historically significant 'Guildford City', after an absence of thirty years. 2007-2008 saw City claim a runner up finish in the CCL Premier League, under the management of Scott Steele and Lloyd Wye. Then saw a period of struggle which was alleviated by the appointment of Kevin Rayner who took charge in spring 2009. His second season saw a club best run in the FA Vase, an incredible FA Cup victory at Isthmian Premier Tonbridge Angels, but also the CCL Premier Division Championship. A second Combined Counties Championship was gained in 2012, resulting in an emotional return to the Southern League after a gap of 38 years. That first Step 4 season saw a creditable ninth place finish in the Central division. At the end of 2012-13 Rayner departed for a new chapter in his career. In November 2013 Rayner returned to the Spectrum to lead an unsuccessful battle against relegation.

After a poor start to the 2014-15 CCL season, Kevin Rayner departed in November to be replaced by local coach Donovan Chislett who saved the club from relegation in an exciting climax to the season. Chislett himself departed in September 2015 to be replaced by former Godalming & Farncombe Athletic FC manager Dean Thomas. Then commenced a Guildford musical chairs! After exactly 12 months Dean departed to be replaced by his assistant Steve Dormer. Dormer in turn saw the 2016-17 season out before departing to be replaced by his assistant Chris Balchin. After four seasons at the helm Balchin departed in December 2020 to be replaced as part of a club restructure by ex-Staines Town manager Paul Barnes. After a disappointing start to 2021-22 Barnes departed, with Tristan Rees stepping up in a caretaker role. On 31 January 2022 former Aldershot Town goalkeeping legend Nikki Bull was appointed manager only for him to resign after only five weeks. In May 2022 Peter Ruggles was appointed manager with stability being the main aim of the season.

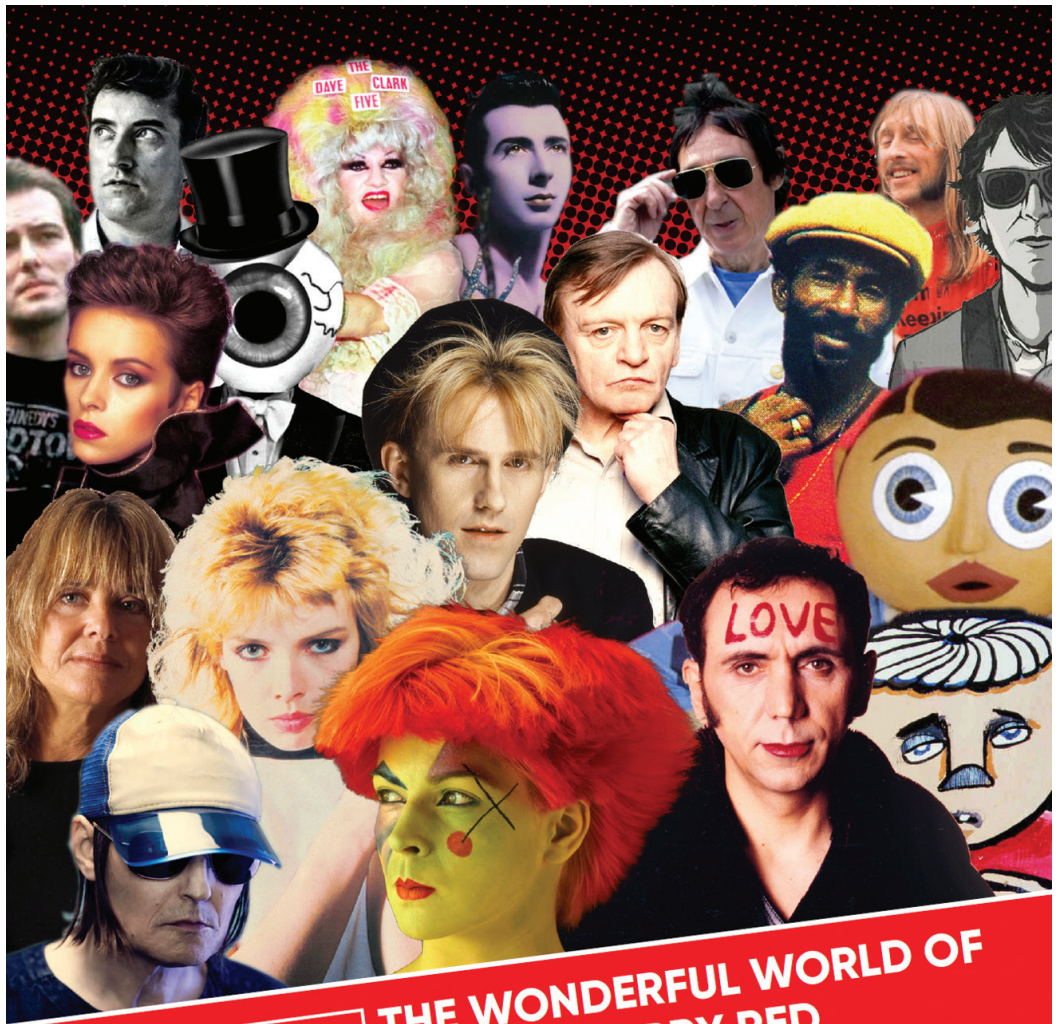
