Balham FC is run by a Board of Directors: Greg Cruttwell, Derek Fordham and Jennie Molyneux. They are joined on the Club Committee by Zoe Appleton, Len Chapman and Steve Pigott.

The club was originally founded by Greg Cruttwell in 2001 as Balham Blazers FC. It started with one Under 10 team in 2001/02 playing in the London County Saturday Youth Football League. Following on from their success more age group teams have gradually been added and the club now offers a direct pathway in boys' football from Under 7 to Senior First Team semi-professional level at Step 5 in the Football League Ladder.

The club also has an ever-expanding, high achieving, County Cup winning girls section which currently offers football from Under 10 to Under 16 and a pathway into the Senior Women's team who play in the Greater London Women's Football League Division 2 South.

Following a playing ethos of trying to bring a bit of Barcelona to Balham the age group section of the club has been extremely successful to date, winning and being runners up in over 600 League and Cup Competitions, which includes being Champions of London. The club, which has a partnership agreement with Fulham FC, has also been an unprecedented three-time winner of the London FA Charter Standard Community Club of

the Year Award and a four-time winner of the Wandsworth Sports Club of the Year Award.

After nine seasons of age group football between 2001-2010 an Under 18 Youth team was launched. The team played for seven seasons in the Southern Youth League.

The team moved into the newly formed Combined Counties League Youth Section for the 2017/18 season. In 2018/19 the team were League Champions and League Cup Winners and in 2022/23 they were East Division Runners Up.

Following the launch of a Youth team the flagship First Team was founded as Balham FC in 2011. Having won back-to-back promotions in 2011/12 and 2012/13, Balham did the League and Cup double in the Surrey South-Eastern Combination League in 2013/14.

In 2014/15 Balham finished in a promotion position again, in the Surrey Elite Intermediate Football League, however promotion was denied due to Combined Counties League facility requirements not being met. Having moved to ground share with Cobham FC, to meet the facility requirements, Balham finished as Runners Up in the SEIFL in 2015/16 and as a result were promoted to Division One of the Combined Counties League for the 2016/17 season. The club had an exceptional first league campaign at Step 6, finishing in a promotion position for the sixth

consecutive season and winning the London Senior Trophy. In 2017/18 the club had an equally exceptional season finishing 5th at Step 5 in the Premier Division of the CCL and winning the London Senior Cup. 2023/24 will be the club's seventh season at this level after flirting with relegation in 2018/19 and then having null-and-void seasons in 2019/20 and 2020/21 due to COVID-19. Having begun on Wimbledon Extension, before moving to Cobham and then to the Wibbandune Stadium, where the club ground shared with Colliers Wood United, Balham moved again in 2020, this time to the Mayfield Stadium, where the club embarked on a ground share

agreement with AFC Croydon Athletic. Moving location meant having to move sideways in the Football League Pyramid, from the Premier Division of the CCL into the Premier Division of the SCEFL (South East Counties Football League) After one single season in the SCEFL however, the FA brought Balham back to the Combined Counties League for the 2021/22 season, at the same level, in a newly formed Premier League South. Since returning the club has finished 8th in the league in 2021/22 and 9th in 2022/23, a season in which The Blazers (Balham's club nickname) were also Southern Combination Cup Runners Up.

HILLTOP FC

Hilltop Football club is based in Stonebridge and was founded in 2005. They are currently members of the Combined Counties League Premier Division and groundshare with Hillingdon Borough at the Middlesex Stadium.

The club was named after a road in Stonebridge called Hilltop Avenue, where most of the players lived at the time when the club was formed.

In 2007, they joined Division Three of the Middlesex County League and gained promotion to the second division at the first attempt. Then, after just two seasons playing in Division Two, the club left the league.

Hilltop eventually re-joined the Middlesex County League Division Two in the 2014/15 season, and the following season were relegated to Division Three having finished bottom of

the league.

However, the club's management was reformed at this point in their brief history, and success followed. After finishing second in the league, the club was promoted back to Division Two and has since enjoyed a series of triumphs. They won the league at the first attempt and, with it, earned promotion to the Middlesex County Leagues Division One.

The 2018/19 season was another turning point for the club. At the first attempt, Hilltop won the league without losing any games and only conceded 13 goals over the whole season. They also won the Middlesex County Junior Cup, defeating Western Athletic 6-1 in the final, but were denied a treble as they lost the final of the Jim Rodgers Presidents Cup to Clapton CFC.

After the reconstruction of the non-league football pyramid, the Hilltop were promoted to the Combined Counties Football League Division One on the back of winning the 2019/20 Middlesex County League Premier Division on points-per-game after a season that was ended early due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

In their first season as semi-professional club, Hilltop surprised many with their style of football and managed to finish 2nd in Combined Counties Football League Division One and losing the playoff final, missing out on promotion to Combined Counties Premier Division.

However the club was promoted to the Combined Counties Premier Division, having been offered the vacancy left by Staines Town. This makes it back-to-back promotions for Hilltop,

who continue to go from strength to strength.

As the first team has risen through the leagues, the wider club has developed too. 2021/22 season, they launched a reserve team who competed in Division One of the Middlesex County League, as well as a women's team who compete in the Greater London Women's Football League, not to mention a number of youth teams.

Last season the first team finished 13th in their first season as a step 5 club, Reserves won the Middlesex County Division 1 League and gained promotion to the Premier Division. The Women's also gained promotion to Division 1 North of Greater London Women's Football League after finishing 2nd in the Division 2 North.

Hilltop draws many of its players from the Somali community in London, and from time to time enters Somali tournaments around the world, having done so in Canada and Somalia. They also participate in the Somali British Champions league, of which they are the current holders.

The team's success in recent seasons, and their exciting brand of football, has not gone unnoticed. Hilltop manager Abdullah Mohammed was recently appointed as the assistant coach of the Somali national team, and forward Ali Mohamed received a call-up to the senior Somalia side for the first time in 2021 as well.

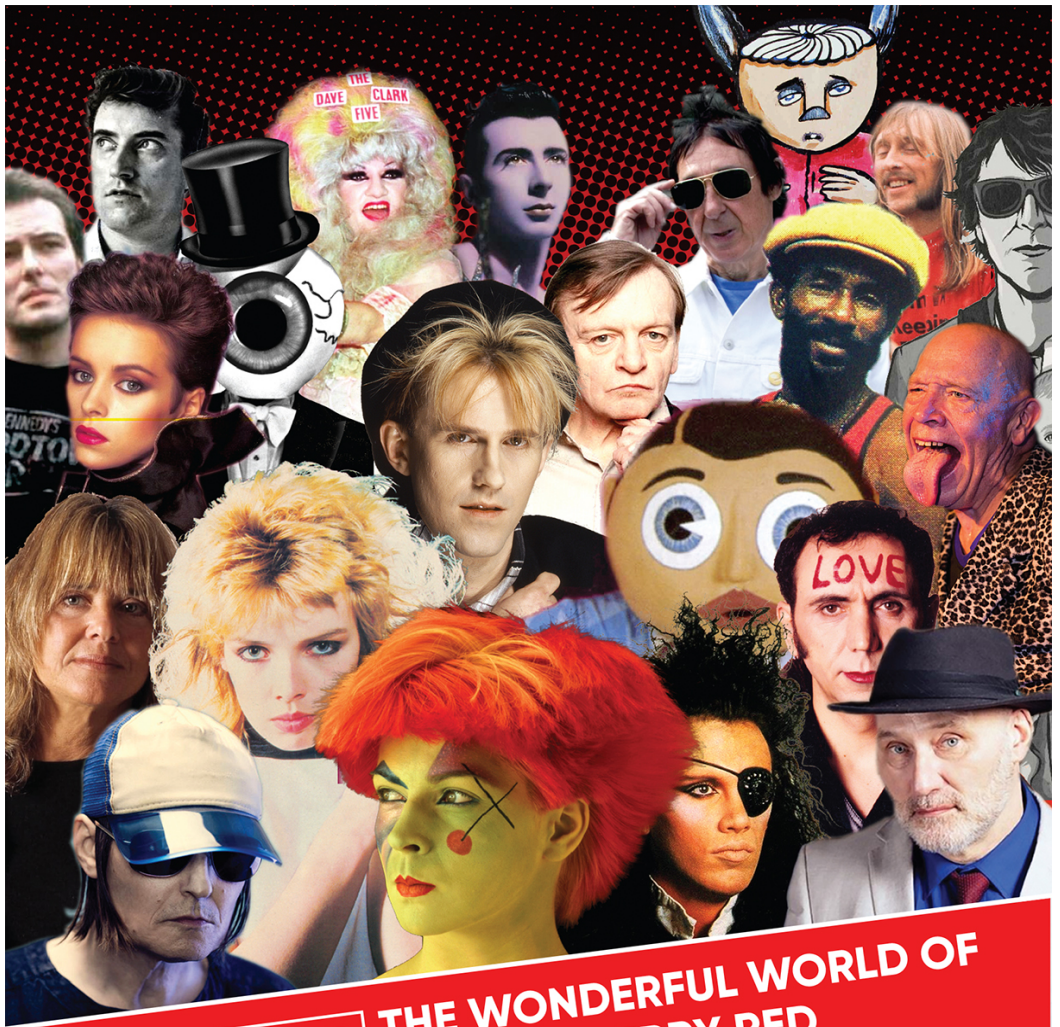
