Hello and welcome to the LHP stadium for the last game of the season. Perhaps today is not the time for reflection but as this will be our last communication of the current season it is appropriate to look back.

To win the Cymru South is a very, very, difficult task - the last three promoted clubs Barry Town; Briton Ferry and Llanelli all have had one major thing in common- THE BIGGEST BUDGET. However, even with the biggest budget you still have to do the job so congratulations to Lee Kendall; Andy Dyer and Lee John for getting their teams over the line.

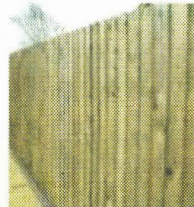

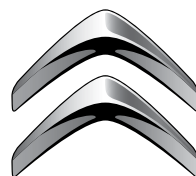



CARMARTHEN TOWN WOMEN'S TEAM SEASON REVIEW 2024-25

Pre season saw our Women's 1st team promoted to Tier 3 of the FAW Pyramid, the South Wales Women's and Girls League and also our U19's being confirmed once again into the FAW Genero Adran South Under 19's League.

The 1st team's season started with a strong showing winning games in both league and cup. The FAW Bute Energy Welsh Cup qualifying round saw us overcome Trefelin BGC Women and Round 1 saw us dispatch Tier 2 side Swansea University 5-1. Round 2 of the Cup saw us draw Adran Premier side Swansea City Women, a massive test for the team. After a valiant effort, we fell short losing 0-3 to the Swans in a closely contested match.

2025 started with the Women's team unbeaten in their League campaign and also competing in the SWWGL Alun Evans League Cup. Consistent performances in both competitions saw, at the writing of this article, the Women's team topping their League. It also saw them progress through to the Semi Final of the League Cup with a strong 5-1 win against Llanrumney FC Women last Sunday (6th April). Additions to the squad were made in January and with players now returning from injury it has given us a great platform to finish the season strongly.

The Under 19's made an excellent showing once again with a 6th place finish in their League at the end of the season. They once again maintained an unbeaten record against Swansea City, and also beat the eventual League winners Cardiff City 4-1 at home in September. It has been pleasing to see progressive growth in performances, ability and togetherness within the female section and it gives me confidence that there is a lot more to come from this group.

HANES / HISTORY : C.P.D PENRHIWCEIBER PENRHIWCEIBER A.F.C.



Penrhawceiber Rangers, formerly Penrhawceiber Welfare were formed in 1961 and have played all their football on their Glasbrook Field. Founder members were Billy Cooksley, Tony Jones and Chris Kerr. The club saw great advances through the nineties winning the South Wales Amateur League and Corinthian Cup in the 1991-92 season, with promotion to the Welsh Football League.

In their first season in the Welsh League, Penrhawceiber just missed out on promotion in 4th place on goal difference to Milford United, while also suffering heartbreak in the League Cup Final losing to Pembroke Borough at Coychurch Road in Bridgend. The following season, 1993-94, Penrhawceiber won the Third Division title, winning 19 of their 26 league games to pip runners up Grange Harlequins by a point to win promotion to Division 2. This was followed by a second consecutive title, with the Division 2 Championship brought home, holding off rivals Risca United, with 17 wins in 26 league games.

The club's first season in Division 1, led to a very creditable 7th place finish, however the following season Ceiber were relegated back to Division 2, but the stay was to be short lived. The club bounced back in 1998-99, winning the title with 21 wins in 30 league games.

The club then had three seasons of consolidation in the Division 1, with 10th, 11th and 12th place finishes, before relegation again in 2002-03. The following three seasons saw mid-table finishes, although the League Cup was won in 2006 with victory over Pontardawe Town, 2-1 at Afan Lido. However, Ceiber suffered further relegation in 2006-07 back to Division 3. However, the club instantly bounced back with a 3rd place finish in 2007-08 behind Pentwyn Dynamos & Newcastle Emlyn.

In 2008-09 the club reached the League Cup for the third time but suffered heartbreak in losing to Afan Lido on penalties 6-5 after a 1-1 draw at Maesteg. The club made no mistake in 2009-10 though in the league, with 21 wins in 34 league games to win the Division 2. The club suffered instant relegation though and after 5 seasons back in Division 2 suffered a further relegation in 2015-16. The club then missed out to Trefelin for one of just two promotion spots in 2018-19. However, with the league re-structuring Ceiber won the very last Welsh League Division 2 title in 2019-20 on the points per game average after Division 3 became Division 2, with the formation of the Cymru South.

In season 2023-24 Penrhawceiber won the league and were promoted to the Cymru South for the first time in their history.

REWRITING HISTORY: The True Beginnings of Carmarthen Town AFC

Many of you may recognise 1948 as the founding year of Carmarthen Town AFC, as displayed on the club's current badge. However, after years of research, I have presented evidence to the Carmarthen Town committee that challenges this long-held belief. My findings suggest that the club was, in fact, established in 1950. Due to the limited written records within the club's archives, much of its early history has been passed down orally, leading to inevitable errors and inconsistencies over time.

For the past seven years, I have been meticulously piecing together a comprehensive archive of match results, goal scorers, and reports. Although further research is still needed, I plan to publish the bulk of my findings during the 2025/26 season to commemorate the club's 75th anniversary. The pivotal figure behind the establishment of Carmarthen Town AFC in 1950 was Jack Harding. Having moved to Carmarthen from England shortly after the First World War, Harding quickly became a key influencer in the local football scene. He was instrumental in forming several teams over the years, starting with 'Carmarthen Town Football Club' in 1919. This team played home games at Norton's Field, Morgan's Arms Field, and Carmarthen Park. After a season of friendly matches, they joined the Swansea District League for the 1920-21 season but disbanded shortly thereafter.

Harding then founded Quay Rovers FC in 1926, but due to difficulties in fielding a consistent team and securing a stable home ground, the club merged with St. Peter's Church House FC in 1930 to form St. Peter's Rovers FC. This new club remained active until the outbreak of the Second World War. In 1946, Harding once again attempted to establish a lasting football club with 'Carmarthen Athletic Football Club,' but it survived for only one season.

By 1950, the demand for a new representative football club for the town had grown significantly. On Friday, 26th May 1950, a pivotal meeting took place at the Red Lion pub in Carmarthen to discuss the formation of a new team. While there was strong support for establishing a club, securing a suitable home ground proved challenging.

The club was officially founded on Tuesday, 18th July 1950, at a public meeting held at the Dolwar Café, where the name 'Carmarthen Town AFC' was agreed upon. The inaugural committee included, R.M. Parry (Chairman), Jack M. Harding (Secretary), Jack John (Assistant Secretary), T.H. Evans (Treasurer). Other committee members included Bob Parry, Aneurin Parry, Jimmy Hughes, W.E. Wright, and Albert Davies. Until Carmarthen entered the Welsh League in 1954, the committee was responsible for selecting the first-team lineup.

The club initially sought permission from the Town Council to use the New King George Field, located partially on the site of what is now Richmond Park. However, the field was deemed too small for senior football. To create a full-size pitch, two large hedgerows needed to be removed. While the committee offered to undertake this work themselves, it was a time-consuming task. As a temporary solution, the club arranged to play home games at Penllwyn Park.

In December 1950, Carmarthen Town Council took over the project and instructed the Borough Engineer to develop the 'Richmond Terrace Playing Fields Scheme' at a cost of no more than

£1,000. Carmarthen Town eventually moved into Richmond Park in the summer of 1954. However, the pitch remained under council ownership until the club secured its lease in 1998.

Carmarthen Town AFC held a player trial on Saturday, 19th August 1950. One week later, on Saturday, 26th August, they played their first friendly match, defeating Llanelli-based Zammitts 2-0 with goals from T. Wareham and Miles Harding, plus a crucial penalty save by goalkeeper Meurig Wrentmore. Their next match, just three days later at Carmarthen Park, ended in a thrilling 3-3 draw against Welsh League side Pembroke Borough, with Miles Harding and Harold Harding (2) finding the net.

Initially, the club faced a setback when their application to join the Carmarthenshire League was rejected. However, after a resounding 5-1 friendly victory against Cilgerran, featuring a hat trick from Harold Harding and a brace from Stan Welsh, an unexpected opportunity arose. Porthyrhyd FC had withdrawn from Carmarthenshire League Division 2, allowing Carmarthen Town to take their place for the 1950-51 season.

Carmarthen Town AFC played their inaugural league fixture on Saturday, 16th September 1950, at Penllwyn Park against Burry Port Suburbs. Despite trailing 1-0 at halftime, the club's first-ever official league goal came when Percy Jones' cross was headed into the net by centre-back Stan Welsh. Harold Harding added a second goal, but a late goalkeeping error by Meurig Wrentmore allowed Burry Port Suburbs to equalise, resulting in a 2-2 draw.

Carmarthen Town ended their debut season with a strong second-place finish in Carmarthenshire League Division 2, earning promotion to Division 1. They also reached the semi-finals of the Carmarthenshire League Senior Cup, ultimately losing in a replay to eventual winners Bwlch Rangers.

The rich and complex history of Carmarthen Town AFC is a testament to the dedication of individuals like Jack Harding, who tirelessly worked to establish a sustainable football club for the town. By correcting the club's founding date, we can ensure that its history is accurately recorded and celebrated for generations to come.

Carmarthen Town (1) – (1) Trefelin BGC

Saturday 30th March 2025, Cymru South, LHP Stadium

A dramatic injury time goal from Noah Daley ensured Carmarthen Town secured a hard-fought 2-2. A depleted Carmarthen Town side battled through late pressure to secure a hard-fought point at the LHP Stadium. With injuries and suspensions forcing a reshuffle, forwards Liam Thomas and Noah Daley were deployed in unfamiliar central midfield roles, while teenage trio Ryan Bond-Morgan, Sean Richards, and the aptly named Elis James led the attack.

After an even start with neither goalkeeper tested, Carmarthen carved out the game's first real chance in the 20th minute. The lively James twisted away from former Swansea City defender Shaun MacDonald before flicking the ball to Richards, who in turn found Bond-Morgan. The 18-year-old stepped into the penalty area but saw his low shot whistle just past the near post.

Nine minutes later, Carmarthen made their pressure count. Gavin Jones whipped in a corner from the left, and veteran defender Lee Surman rose at the far post to head into the bottom corner, giving the home team a deserved lead.

Carmarthen continued to press early in the second half. Daley, searching for his 27th goal of the season, showcased his skill in the 53rd minute—picking up the ball in midfield, sidestepping three opponents, and attempting an audacious chip from 45 yards over Trefelin goalkeeper Alex Pennock. Agonizingly, his effort bounced just wide. Pennock was beaten five minutes later when Bond-Morgan unleashed a driven effort toward goal, only for a deflection to send the ball narrowly the wrong side of the post.

With Carmarthen tiring, Trefelin seized the initiative. In the 70th minute, 48-year-old Lee Trundle—quiet until this point—collected the ball inside the Carmarthen box. With his trademark close control and back to goal, Trundle spun sharply, drawing a challenge from James Dolman. Referee Jordan Harman immediately pointed to the spot. Steve Berry stepped up, but Carmarthen keeper Lee Idzi produced a superb save, diving low to his right to deny the equaliser.

Two minutes later, Trefelin thought they had drawn level when Joseph Jones' cross found Trundle at the far post. The veteran striker controlled the ball on his chest and rifled a volley past Idzi, but the referee ruled out the goal for handball. The pressure eventually told in the 84th minute. Joe Clarke's curling left-footed cross found Jones, who arrived ahead of Idzi to nod the ball home, despite Gavin Jones' desperate attempt to clear off the line.

Trefelin pushed for a winner, and former Carmarthen player Callum Saunders almost found it with a stunning 25-yard strike, but Idzi pulled off a spectacular save, tipping the ball onto the crossbar. In the dying moments, Trundle had one final attempt, only for Idzi to palm his shot away, ensuring Carmarthen held on for a point.

Baglan Dragons (1) – (1) Carmarthen Town

Saturday 5th April 2025, Cymru South, Evans Bevens Playing Fields

Carmarthen Town were forced to settle for a 1–1 draw in their final away fixture of the season against Baglan Dragons, as an early strike from Toby Jones was cancelled out by a second-half equaliser from Artion Legavec in challenging blustery conditions at the Evans Bevens Playing Fields.

With a strong wind at their backs, the Old Gold started brightly and dominated the first half. Goalkeeper Lee Idzi's clearances were regularly reaching the edge of Baglan's penalty area, setting the tone for Carmarthen's early pressure. Just five minutes in, a long ball from Idzi was nodded down by Jones into the path of Sam Parsons, whose volley flew over the bar.

The breakthrough came in the ninth minute. Parsons delivered a curling corner that was headed back across the face of goal by Morgan Weaver. Toby Jones was perfectly positioned at the back post to nod the ball goalward. Baglan's Jonathan Davies scrambled to clear, but the assistant referee flagged to confirm the ball had crossed the line.

Carmarthen had a golden chance to double their lead in the 18th minute. Weaver picked out Toby Jones in midfield, who turned neatly and threaded a perfectly weighted pass to Noah Daley. After sidestepping Baglan 'keeper Mathew Stanton, Daley, usually so clinical, rolled the ball just wide with the goal at his mercy. The visitors continued to press, and two minutes later, Rio Booth fired a powerful 25-yard effort into the side netting.

After the break, the momentum shifted dramatically. Now with the wind behind them, Baglan pressed high and controlled both possession and territory. Within seconds of the restart, Thomas Davies fired narrowly over from 10 yards.

In the 55th minute, Carmarthen broke swiftly on the counter following a cleared Baglan corner. Bond-Morgan released Daley through the middle, but the forward squandered the opportunity, blasting wide from 10 yards with only Stanton to beat.

Baglan finally got their reward in the 65th minute. A speculative long ball from left-back Kieran Parsons was partially cleared by Weaver. The ball fell awkwardly to Sam Parsons, whose attempted clearance with his weaker foot landed straight at the feet of Tom Randall. Randall squared the ball to Legavec inside the box, and the striker coolly slotted past Idzi to level the score.

From then on, Carmarthen were under sustained pressure. Legavec tested Idzi again just two minutes later, cutting inside and forcing a low save, before Randall's fierce drive was parried away by the veteran keeper. Baglan should have taken the lead shortly after when Thomas Davies found himself unmarked at the back post from a corner but somehow failed to hit the target.

There was late drama in stoppage time as Toby Jones lofted a clever pass over the top for Daley. A challenge from Connah Troy deflected off Daley, looping over Stanton but dropping just wide of the far post.

Colwyn Bay and Airbus UK - who are the only sides in contention for the JD Cymru North title on this final weekend of the campaign - have also been granted Tier 1 licences, meaning the champions will be promoted.

Those who have been refused a licence by the FIB have 10 days to submit an appeal. A club spokesperson stated “One of the requirements of obtaining the licence is a youth academy and we thank our coaches from under 8 to 18 for ensuring that our Academy is a successful one. Congratulations to Llanelli Town on their success and we are proud that we are the only other Cymru South side to be granted a Tier 1 license in the first instance. This is due to years of investment in our excellent infrastructure, our excellent Academy and is yet again evidence of a club well run.”

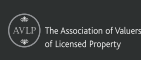
